


6th Grade Students wait outside of the 6th grade entrance.

Students go to their lockers and then begin their day in himusim.





Marking Periods and Semesters

Four Marking Periods (Quarters)

- •Each is approximately 9-10 weeks (1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th)
- •Exploratories (other than band and PE) change each MP
- •Report Cards are sent home at the end of each marking period
- •Classroom progress reports are available throughout the year

Two Semesters

- •Two marking periods per semester
- •(1st and 2nd semester)
- •PE is a semester-long class

Important Tools: PowerSchool & Schoology



PowerSchool - Student Information System (SIS), the school's official record-keeping and administrative system.

- Viewing **official grades** and report cards
- Checking attendance records
- Managing student schedules (Each Marking Period it updates/changes!)
- Accessing transcripts and standardized test scores
- Parent Contact Information
- Enrollment and emergency contact updates
- App & Login Available for parents/guardians and students (Parents can attach multiple student profiles to their account, so children from other PPS buildings can be accessed from the app)



Schoology - Learning Management System (LMS), the classroom's digital hub for learning and communication.

- Viewing daily assignments, classwork, and homework
- Based on teacher use, seeing **teacher feedback** and assignment **scores**
- Accessing class materials, resources, and agendas
- Participating in discussions or submitting assignments online
- Parents can gain access, but they will not have the same access as their child
