FIRST Lego League's (FLL) mission is "to inspire young people to be science and technology leaders and innovators, by engaging them in exciting mentor-based programs that build science, engineering, and technology skills, that inspire innovation, and that foster well-rounded life capabilities including self-confidence, communication, and leadership." ## There are three levels of FLL:

Discover is for grades K-1

Explore is for grades 2-4

Challenge is for grades 4-6

The number of teams will depend on both student interest and number of adults willing to coach and mentor teams.

Most programs will meet one day a week, either after school or in the evening, typically at the high school. Frequency of meetings may increase for upper levels or as competition dates approach in order to complete projects, prepare presentations, etc. All programs start this fall and most will be done before Christmas Break.

Registration fees are listed below. There are scholarships available to cover ½ of the cost, with additional financial assistance available for families in need.

Discover is \$15

Explore is \$20

Challenge is \$30
