The family of Jerry Wayne Hull would like to recognize and support Petoskey High School students who wish to pursue their interest in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM).

While a Petoskey High School student (Class of 1955), Mr. Hull was a finalist in the prestigious national Westinghouse Science Competition. After graduating from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, with a degree in engineering, Mr. Hull's love of learning, disciplined scientific inquiry and hard work let to a rich and fulfilling computer-science career in California. In the 1960's and 1970's, at the Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, California, Mr. Hull was part of the teams that designed the computer programs for several moon and interplanetary space missions. At the RAND Corporation (Santa Monica, California) a nationally known think-tank for both defense and civilian research, Mr. Hull continued to apply his creative computer-programming skills.

The Jerry W. Hull scholarship is an award of \$500.00 to one Petoskey High School student (currently in the 9th, 10th or 11th grade) who has an interest in and/or potential toward furthering their knowledge by taking a summer instructional program in STEM related study

Students applying should demonstrate academic ability (minimum GPA of 3.5) in related coursework. Some exceptions to this requirement may be made for students with special needs or abilities whose applications meet the other requirements.
